

From Central, Southern and Eastern Arkansas by I-40

- Take I-40 to Alma, and turn north on I-540 towards Fayetteville. Rogers is approximately one hour north of Alma.
- If you are planning to stay locally, the best exit is 85, which is marked "Rogers/ Bentonville Highway 71-B". It is known locally as "West Walnut Street" in Rogers and "Walton Boulevard" in Bentonville.
- Most of the hotels will be on your left as you exit the freeway.
- From exit 85, you can come to our offices by traveling east (right turn from freeway) approximately 2.1 miles (6 traffic lights) to N. Dixieland Road.
- Turn left (north) on N. Dixieland and go one-half mile through the traffic light at Olive. Our offices are on your left in a building marked "Crossroads".

Alternate Directions

- If you are not planning on staying locally, the best exit is 86, which is marked "Rogers/ Bentonville, 62-B and 102". This is also known as "Hudson Road".
- Take a right at the bottom of the freeway ramp and travel 1.9 miles (3 traffic lights) to N. Dixieland Road.
- Turn right (south) onto N. Dixieland Road and travel approximately eight tenths of a mile to a marked school zone.
- Once you have entered the school zone, our drive is the first on the right in a building marked "Crossroads".

From Northern and Northeastern Arkansas by Hwy 62

- Arriving in Rogers from Eureka Springs (approximately 1 hour), the Rogers airport will be on your right.
- The next traffic light will be at the junction of Hwy's 62-B and 94. Stay in the right lane on Hwy 62 straight through the light and straight again when the road forks about four tenths of a mile later. You will be staying on Hwy 62 west, also known as "Hudson road". The signs will indicate that you are going toward Bentonville, Springdale and Fayetteville.
- Once you have gone past the fork, travel one mile to the 2nd traffic light. This is N. Dixieland Road.
- Turn left (south) onto N. Dixieland Road and travel approximately eight tenths of a mile to a marked school zone.

Once you have entered the school zone, our drive is the first on the right in a building marked "Crossroads".
